Description

Providers from the North Carolina Pediatric Access Line (NC-PAL) will offer guidance in the screening, assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of ADHD in children and adolescents. This presentation will be targeted towards pediatric providers in primary care and is strategically timed for the start of the academic school year.

NC-PAL is a telephone consultation program designed to help pediatric health care providers address the mental health needs of children and adolescents in the counties of Vance, Granville, Franklin, Warren, Halifax, and Person. It is a collaboration between Cardinal Innovations Healthcare and Duke Psychiatry and is a component of Duke Integrated Pediatric Mental Health.

Objectives
